WHY IS THIS STUDY BEING DONE?

Over 100 million adults in the U.S. are living with diabetes or prediabetes.

Reduced brain function (cognitive decline), including memory issues, affects 1 in 9 adults in the U.S.

Rates of cognitive decline are higher in people with diabetes and the link between cognitive decline and diabetes is not well understood.

Latinos are at higher risk for diabetes and Alzheimer's disease. Latinos are also underrepresented in diabetes and cognitive decline research.

WHAT IS INVOLVED IN THE STUDY?

Participants will be invited to come to USC for a series of study visits that include medical exams, memory assessments, lab tests, and MRI imaging scans. Lab tests include blood work and an optional collection of spinal fluid.

Participants will be asked to return yearly over a 5 year period.

Test results and MRI images will be provided to you by request.

All testing is free and neither you nor your health insurance or plan will be billed for taking part in this study.
